

THE LIVESTOCK AND HOLY MASS FAIR

The cattle fair dates back to 1954, according to oral sources who lived their beginnings. Already in 1974, the Hon. Tenerife Island Council became an important part seeing the rise of this fair, with subsidies for aid of transfers of farmers and their respective livestock. Neighbors, ranchers and people from different parts of the island come with their animals (horses, cows, goats, dogs ...) to the exhibition for the blessing of livestock by the parish priest of the neighborhood, during the celebration of Holy Mass. It ends with the delivery of trophies to different categories of livestock.



As it could not be less, the Holy Mass is enlivened with Canarias chants and both before and after this the transfer of the patron saints is carried out in procession from the temple to the fairgrounds and vice versa.
